Description of Project:

- a) Goal/need of the project: The VCP is intended to create an everlasting place for the City of Surprise and the Northwest Valley community to commemorate and memorialize military members from all branches of service and dates served. Phase I of the project was completed in July 2014. Phase II was completed in June 2016. Fundraising is currently ongoing to raise funds to complete Phase III and conduct a dedication ceremony.
- b) How support has evolved in the neighborhood: The project started in the Marley Park community and has spread throughout the City of Surprise and the Northwest Valley.
- c) Who is involved: The VCP Committee consists of residents from the Marley Park community, representatives from the DMB Associates Inc, and representatives from the local VFW organization.
- d) What you expect the benefits to be when project is completed: The VCP will be a place to honor the service and sacrifices of all military personnel. The VCP will also be a place to generate interest for our younger generations to learn more about what it means to serve our country.

Phase I (Paid): Fabricate precast concrete for pentagon base, install flagpole and bronze plates, masonry, engrave pavers \$22,572

Phase II (Paid): Fabricate materials and installation of five benches \$9009

Phase III (Paid): Fabricate masonry column and precast concrete for Entrance pedestal, install pedestal and pathway lighting, install trash receptacle – \$2032

The Phase III projects that still need to be funded include the purchase and installation of the pet waste bag dispenser and apply a sealant treatment on the wood of the five benches.

**UNANIMOUS WRITTEN CONSENT IN LIEU OF A MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
MARLEY PARK COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC.**

The undersigned, being all of the Directors of MARLEY PARK COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC., an Arizona nonprofit corporation (the “**Corporation**”), pursuant to A.R.S. § 10-3821, as well as Section 3.14 of the Corporation’s Bylaws, do hereby consent to the adoption of the following resolution and declare it to be in full force and effect as if it was adopted at a regularly-scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors:

WHEREAS, in May of 2012, Marley Park Phase I, LLC, an Arizona limited liability company (“**MP Phase I**”), in conjunction with the Corporation, the Marley Park Leadership Team and the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Committee, approved the construction of a Veterans Commemorative Plaza (the “**Project**”) on Lot 2 as set forth on the Final Plat of Marley Park Village Core Phase 1 recorded in Book 1009 of Maps, Page 11, as Instrument No.: 2008-0900709, Official Records of Maricopa County, Arizona.

WHEREAS, the Corporation’s Board of Directors memorialized the approval from MP Phase I for the construction of the Veterans Commemorative Plaza via a Unanimous Written Consent dated July 25, 2012 authorizing the Corporation to begin construction of the Project.

WHEREAS, the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Groundbreaking Ceremony was held on November 11, 2013, and the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Committee raised \$25,000.00 (Twenty Five Thousand Dollars) for the Project. Phase 1 of the Project grand opened on July 4, 2014 with a 30-foot flagpole and an octagon shaped base that includes an emblem for each of the five branches of military service along with “Circle of Honor” pavers.

WHEREAS, the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Committee continues fundraising efforts to complete Phases II and III of the Project. Phase II includes the construction and installation of five benches, and Phase III includes the construction and installation of pathway lights, a garbage receptacle and a dog waste bag station.

WHEREAS, the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Committee has requested the approval from the Corporation’s Board of Directors to make application to the City of Surprise Neighborhood Grant Program, which provides eligible neighborhoods with small grants to fund neighborhood events, functions or community improvements.

WHEREAS, the Corporation desires that the Veterans Commemorative Plaza Committee move ahead and make such application to the City of Surprise Neighborhood Grant

Program in hopes that any funds received through the City of Surprise Neighborhood Grant Program will aid in completing Phases II and III of the Veterans Commemorative Plaza.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Corporation's Board of Directors hereby approve the Veteran's Commemorative Plaza Committee's request to make application to the City of Surprise Neighborhood Grant Program for the purpose of receiving grant monies to aid in the completion of Phases II and III of the Veterans Commemorative Plaza in Marley Park.
