PROGRAM PURPOSE & OVERSIGHT

- To empower residents and increase community engagement, interest and involvement within the City of Surprise
- Surprise Sub-Committee on Community Outreach, Partnerships & Grants makes funding recommendations
- Sub-Committee Members are Council Members Rachel Villanueva (Chair), John Williams and Roland F. Winters Jr.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES

To receive support, projects must:

- Provide a public benefit,
- Result in a product, which benefits a neighborhood or the larger Surprise Community;
- Be feasible for completion by June 15, 2017;
- Involve the benefiting neighborhood in project identification, planning and execution;
- Emphasize neighborhood self-help, or
- Be educational, community-building, or a public physical improvement

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Application must be signed by a minimum of 5 neighbors within applicant's respective residential area supporting ideas and project applicant
- Must include a thorough description of how funding will be utilized
- Project must comply with City and HOA policies
 - Application must include approval of HOA Board, if necessary
