

ORDINANCE # 2017-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SURPRISE, ARIZONA, REPEALING ORDINANCE # 2015-24 WITH RESPECT TO REPORTING AUTHORITY FOR THE CITY ATTORNEY.

WHEREAS, on November 3, 2015, City Council adopted Ordinance # 2015-24, which, among other things, modified the reporting structure of the City Attorney, delegated appointment authority to the City Manager, and delineated the roles of the City Attorney and City Manager;

WHEREAS, City Council desires to reinstate the former reporting and appointment structure under which the City Attorney is appointment by, and directly reports to, the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Surprise, Arizona, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance # 2015-24 is hereby repealed and the provisions of Sections 2-100, 2-101, 2-122, 2-140, 2-141, 3-2 and 3-15 of the City Code are hereby reinstated in the form adopted prior to Ordinance # 2015-24.

Section 2. This Ordinance is effective 30 days after adoption.
